

The Invitae PIN partner program guidelines for academic research study announcements

PIN communications are a great way to keep the community informed about research activities. Invitae will include information about research study recruitment opportunities in newsletter communications to participants who choose to receive them.

This research recruitment notification service is limited to IRB- (US) or ethics board- (ex-US) approved academic research studies.

In exchange for the promotion of the academic study, the investigator agrees:

- To actively promote the PIN to patients for the duration of the study via:
 - A prominent link to the PIN on the study website homepage OR
 - Electronic communications to study participants
- To acknowledge the PIN in publications of studies that use PIN recruitment
- To ensure that all PIN communication is solely for academic research studies and not to recruit for industry-sponsored clinical trials without prior written agreement from Invitae

Invitae reserves the right to decline notification for competitive programs (such as for other online patient-entered registries) or industry-sponsored studies on a case-by-case basis. Notices are provided to participants in an informational nature only and do not constitute an endorsement of any kind by Invitae of the study or trial.
